

SYDNEY INTERNATIONAL BOAT SHOW

DARLING HARBOUR & GLEBE ISLAND

31 JULY - 4 AUGUST



One show two great locations

The Sydney International Boat Show will be held over two locations in 2014, 2015 and 2016 while the new International Convention Centre Sydney (ICC Sydney) and exhibition halls are being created in Darling Harbour. Over the next three years the on-water displays will remain in their traditional marina home at Darling Harbour, while the under-cover displays will be located at the specially built interim exhibition halls at Glebe Island.

FREE event ferries will shuttle you between the two locations. To plan your visit, please take a few minutes to read through this guide. We hope it will help make your day at the Boat Show easier and more enjoyable.

Darling Harbour

Darling Harbour is a few minutes' walk from the Sydney CBD. With plenty of links to public transport and parking nearby, we highly recommend you start your day at the Boat Show from Darling Harbour.

Glebe Island

Glebe Island (not actually an island) is located on the fringe of Balmain near the Anzac Bridge. The free event ferry shuttle between Darling Harbour and Glebe Island takes around 15 minutes.

Pre-paid parking at Glebe Island is extremely limited so even if you'd like to visit the exhibition halls first, Darling Harbour is the best place to start. Event ferry shuttles to Glebe Island start at 8am so you can still get there before the Boat Show doors open at 10am.

Your Boat Show ticket allows you entry into both locations on the day and includes the free event ferry shuttle. Make sure to allow some extra time when planning your day so you can enjoy both venues.

Travelling between the two Boat Show locations

Ferries to Glebe Island will depart from Convention Centre Wharf in Darling Harbour from 8am. While the Show doors won't open until 10am, you can stop into the Lifejacket Lounge featuring the Glebe Island Barbecue for breakfast. It will be a great way to start the day with sensational city views.

- Last ferries from Glebe Island to Darling Harbour depart at 9pm.
- The Wharf at Glebe Island is located outside of Hall 1.

Ferries will run continuously between the two venues on each day of the show. Services will be popular and there may be small waiting times, especially on the Saturday and Sunday of the show, so please be patient and considerate of others.

If you have accessibility requirements please make yourself known to one of the Boat Show Customer Service team members, they will assist with your ferry transfer.

GETTING TO THE SHOW

Darling Harbour is your doorway to the Boat Show

There are plenty of public transport options to help get you there.

Going directly to the Sydney Exhibition Centre @ Glebe Island

If you're heading straight to the exhibition halls at Glebe Island, public transport is still the best option. Take a train to Central Station and then catch a free event shuttle bus to Glebe Island, departing from Bay 13 on Eddy Avenue. Boat Show tickets cannot be purchased at Central Railway Station. The ticket office will be at Glebe Island on your arrival.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Train



Take a train to **Town Hall Station** and walk down Druiitt Street to Darling Harbour. The walk is around 700 metres and should take under 10 mins. You will see the Boat Show ticket booth marquee in Palm Grove at Darling Harbour.

Bus



Plenty of Sydney Bus services stop on nearby Bathurst Street, including the Route 555 free Sydney CBD Shuttle.

Ferry



If you'd like to start your day on the water, ferry services run regularly between Circular Quay and Darling Harbour. Only the event ferry shuttle to Glebe Island is included in your Boat Show ticket so you'll need to buy a separate ticket for Sydney Ferries services.

Light Rail



The closest stop to Darling Harbour is Convention light rail station.

Car



If you choose to drive, we recommend that you make Darling Harbour your first port of call. Public parking stations are located within walking distance of the Darling Harbour marina.

There are a number of parking stations on the city side. The largest stations are on the western side, Harbourside, Entertainment and the parking station at The Star Casino.

At Glebe Island

Parking at Glebe Island is extremely limited and entry to the precinct is via James Craig Road only. If parking at Glebe Island, please make arrangements to drive out prior to 10pm as the venue will be locked down after this time. Pre-paid parking is available at Glebe Island. Spaces are limited and traffic may be heavy around the Glebe Island area, so we highly recommend you park at Darling Harbour or consider the many public transport options available.

LEAVING THE SHOW

FROM DARLING HARBOUR

The last **free event ferry shuttle** back to Glebe Island to collect your car is at 8.00 pm. Plenty of public transport options are available from Darling Harbour - Town Hall is the closest train station. To plan your trip home on public transport, visit www.transportnsw.info or call 131 500.

FROM GLEBE ISLAND

Catch a **free event bus shuttle** to Central Railway Station. The last bus leaves 8.30 pm.
Catch a **free event ferry shuttle** to Darling Harbour. The last ferry leaves Glebe Island Wharf at 9.00 pm

The free transport service only applies for the shuttle bus service between Central Station and Glebe Island and the ferry shuttle service between Darling Harbour and Glebe Island. All other modes of transport referred to in this document will require a valid ticket. **Correct at time of production**
